PORT SANILAC- Agnes Camps, age 94, a resident of Port Sanilac, passed away at her home on Wednesday, May 5, 2021.

She was born on October 20, 1926 in Cardale, Pennsylvania, a daughter of the late Frank and Agnes (Bryja) Pincheck. Agnes married Edward J. Camps on November 16, 1946 in Detroit. He preceded her in death on January 19, 1988.
