LEXINGTON- Albert J. Young, age 91, a resident of Lexington passed away April 19, 2022 at his residence surrounded by his family.

He was born June 20, 1930 in Detroit, MI, the son of the late Clarence (Brig) Young and Margaret (nee Baldes) Young.

After serving in the Marines, Albert returned home to St. Clair Shores where he met his future wife, Letha Goodno. They married in 1951 and enjoyed 70 years of marriage before her passing in November 2020. Albert and Letha raised their family first in St. Clair Shores then moved to the Croswell area in 1969. Al had a long career in law enforcement serving as an officer on the St. Clair Shores Police Dept. and later as Chief of Police in both Lexington and Croswell before his retirement. He enjoyed spending time with his family; loved camping, picnics and playing baseball with his children and grandchildren.

He is survived by his three sons; Albert (Catherine) Young Jr. of Ferndale, George Young of Croswell, Robert (Joy) Young of Croswell and two daughters, Marcia Young of Croswell and Victoria (Eric) Zeller of Croswell; 13 grandchildren, 17 great grandchildren and many nieces and nephews. He is also survived by Letha's beloved Oklahoma Goodno family.

Albert was preceded in death by his wife Letha, his two brothers, Charles (Bud) and George Gunning and three sisters; Margaret Gunning, Harriet (nee Gunning) Mills and Rose (nee Gunning) Pascoe. Cremation has taken place; a memorial gathering will be held 11 AM to 1 PM Wednesday, May 4 at the

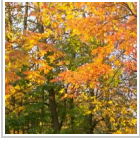

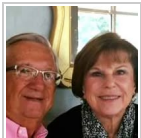
