



## Alma V. Havens

APPLEGATE- Alma Vera (Parker) Havens, age 87, a former longtime resident of Applegate passed away on Tuesday, October 7, 2025, at Meadow Lane in Bad Axe.

She was born on July 16, 1938, in Croswell, a daughter of the late Fred and Vera Alma (Carney) Parker. Alma married Donald B. Havens on April 18, 1958, at the United Methodist Church in Applegate.
