



## Arthur E. Beneker

JEDDO- Arthur E. Beneker, age 88, of Jeddo, Michigan, passed away Wednesday, June 5, 2024 at Water Wheel A.F.C. He was born on December 12, 1935, in Cincinnati, Ohio, to his late parents, Ernst and Bertha (Strohmeier) Beneker.
