Ashley Lynn Nisbett, an inspiring educator, mother, and partner, passed away tragically on October 24th, 2023, at the age of 33.

Ashley was born in Sandusky, Michigan, to Mike and Tammy VanValkenburgh, on May 30th, 1990, and was raised in Deckerville, Michigan. She attended Albion College and began her teaching career in Battle Creek Public Schools. In the final decade of her life, Ashley was a club organizer, educator, mentor, and friend to all at Port Huron Northern High School. Ashley's genuine warmth and grace in dealing with her students, especially those most vulnerable or in need, have left an unforgettable impression on the community.

In May of 2020, Ashley gave birth to the greatest light of her life, Ivan Lionel Nisbett, with her husband and partner of fifteen years, Ryan Nisbett.

Ashley set a remarkable example for all of us, shining a light of hope for those in need and embodying the best of humanity. In keeping with her spirit, we will be holding a memorial celebration to honor her life.
