



## Beatrice B.E. Gordon

June 28, 1931 - September 6, 2022

Beatrice B.E. Gordon, age 91, passed away on Tuesday, September 6, 2022 at United Hospice Residence in Marlette.

She was born June 28, 1931 in Custer Twp., daughter of the late George and Etta (Badgerow) Mitchell. Bea married Charles Gordon on August 4, 1951 and they celebrated 63 years together until his death on Easter Sunday, April 5, 2015.

Bea graduated from Sandusky High School in 1948, went onto Tuscola County Normal and received her B.A. from Eastern Michigan University. She taught at Jones School and Buel Center School, which were both K-8 schools. Bea then taught at Applegate School and the Cros-Lex School system. Altogether, she taught 33 years.

She was a member of the Buel United Methodist Church, where she taught Sunday School for many years. Bea also sang in the choir and was a part of the UMW and the Quilting group, which she enjoyed. She made quilts and other sewing projects for her family. Bea was also a member of the Farm Bureau.

Surviving are her son Fred (Carolene) of Croswell, daughters Linda (Tom) O'Brien of Spring Hill, TN, and Ruth (Tom) Walls of Croswell; 7 grandchildren, 13 great grandchildren, several step grandchildren and great grandchildren; and many nieces and nephews.

Bea was preceded in death by her brothers, David, Harley, Howard, and Bernard Mitchell.

Funeral Services will be held 11 AM Monday, September 12 at Pomeroy Funeral Home, Croswell. Pastor Bruce McCumons will officiate.
