



## Beulah E. Brown

February 6, 1919 - August 4, 2016

FORESTER- Beulah Elizabeth Brown, age 97 of Forester, MI passed away on August 4, 2016. She was born in Yale, MI on February 6, 1919 the daughter of Iva and Oscar Lee Harmer. On June 22, 1939 Beulah married Mark Holden Brown. Both she and Mark worked at the Yale Woolen Mill. Mark was a steam engine operator and Beulah was a loom operator.

On October 19, 1954 Mark and Beulah celebrated the birth of their only child, Sheree Lee. In the early 1960's the mill closed and the family moved to Lexington. Mark worked in an automotive supply factory and Beulah took a job at Kresge's in downtown Port Huron. She then transferred to the new Port Huron K-mart store on 24th street and later became personnel manager at Port Huron's second K-mart on 24th avenue. She also assisted in opening other downriver K-mart stores. By 1981 both Mark and Beulah were retired. In 1990 they moved to Port Sanilac so that they could be closer to Sheree's family in Forester.

Beulah loved working in her flower beds, cooking (everyone especially enjoyed her homemade bread), reading, crocheting afghans, and spending time with her grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

Beulah's passing was preceded by the death of her husband Mark (1993), and brothers Fredrick (2008) and Glenford (2003). She is survived by her

daughter and son-in-law Sheree and Mike Phillips of Forester, MI; two granddaughters Jennifer (Adam) Stone of Baltimore, MD and Lindsey (Jay) Rogers of Berkley, MI; three great-grandchildren Ava, Elaina, and Dean; sister Thelma Bowen of Yale, MI and several nieces and nephews.

Visitation will be at 10:00 AM followed by a memorial service at 11:00 AM at the Pomeroy Funeral Home in Lexington on Saturday, August 13, 2016. Beulah will be laid to rest next to Mark in a private, family only, ceremony later that day in Forester Township Cemetery.

While Beulah loved beautiful flowers, she preferred memorials be given to the Port Sanilac United Methodist Church or to the Sanilac County Humane Society.
