



## Bonnie J. Layman

February 12, 1929 - June 18, 2023

Earth lost a wonderful woman on Sunday morning, June 18, 2023. At age 94, Bonnie J. Rosteck Layman passed away after a short illness. She had wanted to make it to 100 years old, but 94 is still incredible.

Bonnie was born February 12, 1929, in Fraser, Michigan. She graduated from Fraser High School then attended Capital University in Columbus, Ohio. While raising four kids, Bonnie worked as a bookkeeper throughout her life, and spent her spare time being active in charitable organizations such as Blue Water Area Girl Scouts, the Fraser VFW Post #6691, and the Lexington and Croswell Order of the Eastern Star Chapter #236, where she was the Grand Representative to Bolivia in 2012.

Bonnie was predeceased by three brothers (Gerald, Art and Jim Rosteck) , her former husband Harold “Tokyo” Layman and her parents, Marie (Endres) and Arthur Rosteck. She leaves behind four children: Deborah (Richard) Hurley, David (Susan) Layman, Diana Darnell, and Daniel (Morada) Layman, eight grandchildren, and nine great-grandchildren. Bonnie also leaves behind a beloved, and very deaf, Shitzu dog named Sammie.

Bonnie was always up for an adventure: epic road trips, international travel, or Taco Tuesday at the VFW, where she occasionally (but not often) won at pull-tabs. Besides her charitable works, she made her mark socially – spending time with dear friends, playing euchre at the Lexington Senior Center, or showing her grandchildren and great-grandchildren how to be a strong, resilient individual, no matter what life throws at them.
