Carol Ann Gill, age 80, of Sandusky, passed away Saturday, October 30, 2021 at Stonegate Village in Sandusky.

She was born March 11, 1941 in Croswell, daughter of the late Edgar and Belle (Murray) Straffon. Carol was married to Edward L. Gill on February 11, 1961 in Croswell. They were married for 57 years before he preceded her in death on April 19, 2018.
