CARSONVILLE- Charles “Chuck or Charlie” Basler, 81, of Carsonville, passed away on Saturday, December 9, 2023, at his home. He was born on June 9, 1942, in Port Huron, MI to Casper and Betty Basler.

Charles was a graduate of Deckerville High School and Michigan State University. He and his brother owned and operated their family dairy farm, Basler’s Farm, for over thirty years. Chuck was also a former schoolteacher, supervisor and assessor of Bridgehampton Township, longtime school board member of Carsonville-Port Sanilac schools, and most recently the Sanilac Township Treasurer. He was a veteran of the United States Army; a member of the Port Sanilac Masonic Lodge; and an active parishioner of Ave Maria Parish, serving as a lector and a member of the Ave Maria Parish Men’s Club. Charles is survived by his wife of nearly 52 years, Jane (Szczerowski) Basler of Carsonville; his children, Sara McHugh, and Kristen (John) Dandison, both of St. Clair, MI; his grandchildren, Kylie and Harper McHugh, and Patrick, Madeline and Thomas Dandison; brother, John (Connie) Basler; sister, Connie (Larry) Panduren; and numerous nieces and nephews. Charles was predeceased by his parents, Casper and Betty Basler, and his brother, Roger Basler.

Visitation will be held at the Ave Maria Parish-St. Marys Catholic Church in Port Sanilac from 9 - 11 A.M., followed by a Funeral Mass at 11 A.M. on Thursday, December 14, 2023. Fr. Donald J. Eppenbrock will officiate.
