LEXINGTON: Charles R. Whitman, age 72, died Tuesday, May 21, 2013 at his home. He was born July 12, 1940 in Lexington, son of the late Leonard & Marie (Albrecht) Whitman. He and Judith A. Goldschmidt were married September 10, 1966 in Lexington. She died April 24, 2006.

Chuck was a veteran of the U.S. Army. He was member of Cros-Lex Eagles Aerie #4465. He retired as a Tool & Die Maker at Dular, Vassar.
