Croswell- Clifford E. Danielson, age 97, a resident of Croswell formerly of Harper Woods passed away on Tuesday May 27, 2014 at Barss Home in Fort Gratiot.

He was born on April 10, 1917 in Detroit, Michigan a son of the late Edward and Blanche (Mikelson) Danielson. Cliff graduated from Denby High School in Detroit.
