CROSWELL: Dorothy M. Hawks, age 85, of Croswell, passed away peacefully on September 20, 2016 at her granddaughter's home in Croswell. Dorothy was born in a home near Carsonville, Michigan on December 2, 1930 to Harry Reuben Butler and Edna Pearl (Mater) Butler.

Dorothy spent her childhood on a small farm North of Peck. A graduate of Peck High School in 1948, she married Blaine "Bill" Hawks of Croswell, Michigan on April 23, 1954 and lived on his family farm up until the final years of her life. While helping run the farm, Dorothy did the bookkeeping daily to keep all the records accurate.

Dorothy loved vegetable gardening, her flowers and crocheting. She continued to can fruits and vegetable for the remainder of her life. She also loved watching figure skating on television and finding hidden treasures at

garage sales. Most of all, Dorothy cherished the time she spent with family and friends.
