LEXINGTON- Douglas J. LaDouceur, died peacefully at the age of 95 at his home in Lexington, Michigan on February 19, 2025 surrounded by his family. Doug was passionate about supporting many local charities. After retiring in 1991, Doug and Gloria relocated to their 68 acre farm in Lexington, Michigan where Doug was an active member of the Knights of Columbus, on the K of C Golf League, volunteered at St. Denis Catholic Church and at Cros-Lex Project Blessing. Doug enjoyed driving around on his tractors and cultivating a large vegetable garden. They spent their winters in Tampa, Florida as part of the Homes of Regency Cove community, where

Doug played golf and rode his bike daily.

Doug was a loving father, grandfather, brother and uncle to his family and all his children have wonderful memories of family trips, fishing at their cottage, enjoying his culinary skills, and life lessons he has taught them over the years. A Memorial Mass will be held at 11 A.M. on Monday, May 12, 2025 at the Ave Maria Parish-St. Denis Catholic Church in Lexington, with visiting at the church from 10- 11 A.M. Monday morning. Fr.
