LEXINGTON- Dusan "Dan" Kovac, age 92, went to be with his Savior on Wednesday, December 17, 2014 at MediLodge of Fort Gratiot.

He was born March 3, 1922, in Bosnia, to the late Savo and Marta (Goljanin) Kovac. Dan and Emilya Svaga married on October 6, 1951 in Detroit. She preceded him in death March 30, 1997.
