



## Edward Joseph Coury

August 28, 1924 - April 3, 2022

LEXINGTON- Edward J. Coury, age 97, of Lexington passed away on Sunday, April 3, 2022 at his home on Lake Huron with his daughters by his side.

He was born on August 28, 1924 in Detroit, a son of the late John W. Coury and Jennie Salloum. Ed married Anne K. Nolte at the Holy Redeemer Church in Detroit on May 15, 1954. She preceded him in death on March 30, 2007. Ed proudly served in the United States Army during WWII, under the Battery B 8th Division 28th Regiment. He retired from the Ford Motor Co., where he worked as an engineer. Ed was a dedicated and devoted member of the St. Denis Catholic Church in Lexington.

He is survived by two daughters, Rosanne Coury (spouse Michael T.
