



## Edward Earl McPhail

March 21, 1935 - July 21, 2022

Edward Earl McPhail, of Carsonville, passed away at home, with The Lord, on July 21, surrounded by his family.

He was born in Niota, TN to Clifford "Earl" and Edith McPhail on March 21, 1935.

Upon discharge from the Army, where he served in Germany from 1958 to 1960 where he worked on the Spearhead Project, he took his savings and purchased a sawmill. He formed a partnership with his father, which began McPhail and Son. Later in years, a new partnership was formed after his father retired, with his brothers, McPhail Pallets. His favorite sport was Nascar Racing. He built his own race car, raced in Mt. Clemens winning his first race. Ed was also a great hunter as well.
