Edwin John Matthews, 89, of Jeddo passed away at home on December 23 surrounded by his wife and children. He was born on August 21, 1935, to the late Harley and Lucille (Fuller) Matthews in Burtchville Township. Edwin met Noreen Shumate of Port Huron at the roller rink, and later the two were married on August 16, 1958.

After attending the local one room schoolhouse and Croswell High School, Edwin enlisted in the Navy to serve his country and see the world. After a medical discharge, Edwin drove truck as an independent owner/operator, then for Huron Mfg. and Induction Heat Treating. During that time Edwin farmed with his father, purchased his own farm, and in 1986 began his sorting business. He was active in his business until he passed.

Edwin loved to snowmobile, camp, boat and farm. Traveling, whether by Honda Gold Wing or motorhome, was one of his favorite passions. His first motorhome he built himself from a used toy delivery truck. Gardening also became one of his favorite pastimes, specifically hot peppers. Edwin made friends everywhere, including in the Amish and Mennonite communities.

Noreen never knew where the next “adventure” with Edwin would take them! Family has always been a priority, especially his grandchildren and great-grandchildren, whether he was attending graduations, musical events, sporting events, weddings, or any family gatherings.
