Eugene M. Fockler, age 95, of Lexington, passed away on Wednesday, May 4, 2022 at Regency on the Lake.

He was born November 17, 1926 to Louis and Vera Fockler of Deckerville, and grew up on his fathers farm just east of town with his sister Lavena and brothers Keith and Max.

Shortly after graduating from Deckerville High School, he was inducted into the Armed Forces of the United States of America. He faithfully served his country during the Korean War until he was Honorably Discharged from the Army on December 10, 1956.

Gene was a member of the Croswell Wesleyan Church and the Port Sanilac VFW Post #8872. He was the former owner and operator of Gene's Mobil in Lexington.

Eugene married Helen I. Ellis of Marysville at the Deckerville Baptist Church on April 10, 1953. They enjoyed 68 years of marriage until the love of his life, Helen passed away on April 8, 2021.

He is survived by his children, Morris (Wanda) Fockler of Lexington, Thomas (Cindy) Fockler of Croswell and Linda (Tom) McClellan of Croswell; 8 grandchildren, 11 great grandchildren and 1 great great grandchild; several nieces and nephews.
