



## Frederick C. Fogal

April 18, 1953 - November 9, 2014

LEXINGTON- Frederick C. Fogal, 61, of Lexington, died Sunday, November 9, 2014, at his home with his family by his side.

Fred was born April 18, 1953, in Port Huron, the son of the late Maurice (Moe) and Lois Ludy. He was the third child of six in the family.

Fred married Debbie Parker in Lexington on June 28, 1986.
