Georgia Carol Williams, age 77, resident of Carsonville, passed away on Wednesday, December 5, 2018 in her home.

She was born October 23, 1941 in Detroit, daughter of the late Robert and Helen (Hume) Keys. Georgia married Robert Williams on December 22, 1965 in St. Clair Shores.

Georgia graduated from Eastern Michigan University, where she was chosen to be a member of the Mortar Board Honors Society. She was one of only 11 individuals picked out of a college population of 6000. She was a secondary education teacher at Warren Consolidated Schools for 37 years. Georgia also taught at Sanilac and St. Clair Intermediate School Districts. She was a dedicated Christian and an Independent student of the Bible.

Georgia is survived by her husband, Robert; son, Warren of Troy; daughter Elizabeth (Randy) Garver of Commerce Twp.; 2 grandchildren, Sophia and Sam; one brother, Danny Keys; and one sister, Patty Keys.

Funeral Services will be held 11 AM Monday, December 10 at Pomeroy Funeral Home, Carsonville. Burial will be in the Port Sanilac Cemetery.
