



Harold "H" J. Nunn

CROSWELL: Harold Joseph "H" Nunn, age 84, of Croswell, passed away on Sunday, August 21, 2011 at Port Huron Hospital.

Harold was born October 5, 1926 in Lexington Twp. to Harold & Innis (Odlum) Nunn. He married Helen Brown on June 7, 1947 at the Croswell Methodist Church.

He graduated from Croswell High School in 1945. He served in the U.S. Army from 1945 – 1946 and was discharged when the war ended. He worked in Straffon Hardware for 8 years, the City of Croswell for 9 years, and the Cros-Lex Schools as supervisor of busses, custodians, food services, buildings and grounds for 20 years.

H joined the Croswell Fire Department in 1950 where he served until 1980. He was captain, assistant chief, and then chief for 7 years before retirement.

He was a member of the Croswell Agricultural Society (Fair Board) for nearly 50 years. He served as president for 20 of those years. He also was a member of the Michigan Northern Fair and Racing Board where he served a term as president.

Harold was a member of the Croswell United Methodist Church and active in the Men's Group. He was a member of the American Legion, Post #255.

He is survived by his wife, Helen; three sons Kenneth (Linda) of Hemlock, Kim (Cindy) of Croswell, and Kurt (Peggy) of North Street; six grandchildren, Andrea, Katie (Steve) Emert, Kristy (Scott) Hutchinson, John, Brandon (Kristina) and Sarah; one great grandchild, Clare Elizabeth Nunn; and one

brother Clayton of Ruby.

Funeral Services will be 11:00 AM Thursday, August 25, 2011 at the Croswell U. Methodist Church. The Rev. Nick Genoff will officiate. Burial will be at the Croswell Cemetery.

Visitation will be 3 – 9 PM Wed. at Pomeroy Funeral Home, Croswell, and 10 – 11 AM Thursday at the Church.
