PORT SANILAC- Harry Sygit, age 87, of Port Sanilac, died Monday December 28, 2015 at the Sanilac Medical Care Facility in Sandusky. He was born April 26, 1928 in Detroit, son of the late Maximillian H. & Jean (Lewandowski) Sygit, Sr. He and Zana I. Kirkendall were married July 23, 1949 in Forester, she died Sept. 12, 2006.

Harry was a member of the Forester United Methodist Church, which he helped rebuild after the original church burned down, he also served as the Sunday School Superintendant for many years. He worked as a meat cutter at Foley's Market, Port Sanilac and for 21 years at Yale Rubber. A WW II veteran of the U.S. Navy he was a member of V.F.W. Post 8872 Port Sanilac. He liked to hunt, fish, and watch the Detroit Tigers, and make and sell wood lawn ornaments.

He is survived by a son Art of CA; three daughters, Lynne (Burt) Downing of Sandusky, Julie (Doug) Smith of Carsonville, and Charlotte Jahn of Port Sanilac; 12 Grandchildren; 23 Great Grandchildren; and 2 Great Great Grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by sons Lon, Lee and infant Roy; a brother Kenneth Sygit, Sr.; his mother Jean Price Faedie and step father Alex Price. Memorial services will be held at 1 PM on Saturday January 23, 2016 at the Forester United Methodist Church. The Rev. Donna Cartwright will officiate.
