Jesse Ellis Caudill, age 73, of Lexington, passed away Wednesday, August 17, 2022 at Lake Huron Medical Center in Port Huron surrounded by his wife and children.

He was born in Newport, TN, son of the late John C. and Valli F. (Owens) Caudill. Jesse married Debra Hydo on December 26, 1986 in Centerline. At the age of 17, Jesse joined the United States Army. He was sent to Vietnam as a combat Medic; during his deployment in 1967, 68, and 69. He was awarded several medals, ribbons, and stars of accolades.

Jesse was a valued member of Millwrights local 1102. He mastered his skills for 30 years in the millwrights. He used those skills to build his dream of a flying lifestyle. Jesse and Debra built a house, a cabin, and two airplane hangars. He loved to fly his Cessna 182 and Highlander light sport plane. He had the privilege of giving first flights within the Young Eagles Flying Club. "ain't no hill for a stepper"

He is survived by his wife Debra; son, Timothy; daughter Jessalynn (Dan); 2 grandchildren, Mark (Emily) and Bentley; 3 great grandchildren, Saige, Salem, and Sirius; brother, Robert; and sister Dreama.

Jesse was preceded in death by his brother James, and sister, Brenda. A Memorial Service will be held 2 PM Thursday, August 25 at Pomeroy Funeral Home, 5635 Main St, Lexington, Mi.
