Grand Blanc- Jo Ann Hilliker (Galbraith), age 79, of Grand Blanc, passed away at her home surrounded by her family on Saturday, May 12, 2018. Born October 8, 1938 on the farm in Amadore, MI., she was the youngest of eleven siblings. In 1957, she started her career at Chris-Craft in Algonac, MI. When the company transferred their business to Pompano FL., she followed them and remained there until 1959 when she returned to the farm. In 1960 she had an opportunity to move to Flint and work for Westinghouse Credit and then as a legal secretary in a law firm. In May of 1961, she met the love of her life, Duane (Dee) Hilliker. They were married on May 26, 1962. In 1965 she began working in Customer Service at Consumers Power in Flint. She retired in 1975 to become a stay-at-home Mom. Jo Ann was an excellent bowler, member of the 600 club and loved going to the casino.
