Juliet Adele Crowell, age 83, of Croswell, passed away Sunday, September 3, 2023 in her home surrounded by family.

She was born October 25, 1939 in Chicago, daughter of the late Raymond and Margaret (Girard) Carsky. Julie married Richard Crowell on June 16, 1962 in Croswell. They shared a rewarding marriage until his passing on January 15, 1999.

After graduating from Croswell-Lexington in the class of 1957, she earned a bachelor's degree from Eastern Michigan University and later a Master's degree. She was a dedicated elementary teacher at Carsonville – Port Sanilac for 37 years.
