Larry Robert Adams, 74, of Croswell, passed away on Friday, December 20, 2024 at Port Huron McLaren Hospital surrounded by family. He was born April 3, 1950 in Croswell to the late Robert and Katherine (Schott) Adams. Larry and Marcia A. (Dawson) Adams were married July 3, 1970 in Lexington.

Larry served our country in the United States Army from 1969-1972, spending one year in Vietnam with the 59th Combat Engineers Unit (Bushwhackers). After the military, he continued working as a heavy equipment operator, first for Bill Cliff and then over 30 years in the Operating Engineers 324. Larry had the keys to nearly every make and model of heavy equipment built, and was known to test them on machines left unattended.

Larry loved spending time with family. He enjoyed years of bowling and playing pool with friends. He absolutely loved the outdoors. Countless hours were spent on the water fishing or in the woods hunting (and he even tried cliff diving once). These were passions he passed on to his children and grandchildren.
