LEXINGTON- Lorne W. Walker, age 91, of Lexington, died on Friday, January 19, 2024.

He was born on August 11, 1932 in Port Huron a son of the late Alex and Eva Walker. He married Shirley A. Williams on July 18, 1953 at the Grace Episcopal Church in Port Huron.

Lorne graduated from Port Huron High School in 1950 and served in the U.S. Army during th

e Korean War. He retired from Detroit Edison as a consultant after 40 years of service. Lorne was a charter member of the Cros-Lex Jaycees and served in every office. He went on to become State Vice President, Executive Vice President of the Michigan Jaycees and a National Director. He served on the Lexington Village Council as a Trustee for 12 years and then as Village President.

Lorne is survived by his wife, Shirley Walker of Lexington; son, Stephen (Diane) Walker of Gilroy, California, and daughter, Cynthia (John) Haddad of Fairbanks, Alaska.; 6 grandchildren and 8 great grandchildren; 6 special nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his grandson, Philip and his brother, Richard Walker.
