He was born on May 18, 1920 in San Antonio, Texas a son of the late Barbarito and Otilia (Paleo) Ochoa. Manuel married Eliza Gutierrez on Decemeber 10, 1944 in Croswell. Manuel proudly served his country in the U. S. Army during WWII.

Manuel was a recruiter for Michigan Ag. and he retired from Aunt Jane's in Croswell. He was a member of the Ave Maria Parish and the Croswell American Legion.

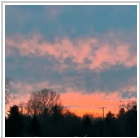
