LEXINGTON Marguerite J. 'Peg' Wright, 87, of Lexington, died Sunday, October 31, 2010 in Port Huron Hospital.

She was born February 11, 1923 in Port Huron, daughter of the late Benjamin E. and Laura R. (Heyraud) Brown. She and John W. Wright were married September 17, 1949 in Port Huron. He died February 11, 1996.

Peg received an Associate Degree from Port Huron Junior College and attended Southern Illinois University in Edwardsville. She was a former Girl Scout leader and camp counselor. She helped organize and was leader of the first Brownie Scout pack in St. Clair County in the 1940's. During WW II she worked at Saginaw Steering Gear, Chevrolet Grey Iron Foundry and Mueller Brass Co. She operated a state licensed foster home for newborn infants through the Michigan Childrens Aid Society and was a home visitation person for shut-ins through Sanilac County Social Services.

In Lexington Peg was a member of the Moore Public Library Board and served on the advisory board for the Lexington Senior Mealsite. She was a member of St. Matthew Lutheran Church. She taught adult bird classes in the Croswell – Lexington area.

She is survived by four sons: Michael D. of Holyoke, MA, Rev. William R. (Dayna) of Sebawaing, Dr. Thomas R. (Mary) of Big Rapids and Rev. Dr. James F. (Lisa) of Altamont, IL. Step son John E. (Carol) of Sterling Heights. One brother Benjamin F. Brown. Eight grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by a sister Martha Watson.

Funeral services will be held at 11 A.M. Wednesday at St. Matthew Lutheran Church, Lexington. The Rev. Barry Sheldon will officiate. Burial will be in Lexington Cemetery.
