LEXINGTON- Marion L. Poma, age 94, a resident of Lexington passed away very unexpectedly on Wednesday, February 4, 2026 at the McLaren- Port Huron Hospital.

She was born on July 30, 1931 in Erie, PA., a daughter of the late Charles and Mary (Bulishak) Stevens. Marion married Joseph A. Poma on January 28, 1950 in St. Clair Shores. He preceded her in death at an early age in 1966. Marion was a Personnel Director at Crowley's Department Store for many years. Marion was also a member of the Ave Maria Parish -St. Denis Catholic Church in Lexington for many years, where she was a member of the Altar Society and sang in the church choir.
