December 19, 1912 - April 18, 2012

Lake Ann- Matilda A. Welsh, age 99, of Lake Ann, Michigan, originally of Forester Township, passed away on Wednesday April 18, 2012. She was born Matilda Adella Casey on December 19, 1912 in Port Sanilac, a daughter of the late William and Margaret (Goodrich) Casey, and was a long-time area resident.

She married William R. Welsh on August 26, 1943 in Napoleon, Ohio. Matilda was a member and past president of Port Sanilac VFW Post #8872 Ladies Auxillary. She worked as an LPN at Childrens Hospital and as a "Rosie the Riveter" at Woodalls in Detroit during World War II.

She is survived by two sons; William L. (Shirley) Welsh of Deckerville and Richard A. Welsh of Lakeland, Florida, a daughter Susan K. Welsh of Lake Ann, a daughter in law Ilene Welsh of Garland, Texas. Several grandchildren, great grandchildren and great great grandchildren. She is also survived by several cousins, nephews and nieces, great nephews and nieces and great great nephews and nieces. Matilda was preceded in death by her husband William on August 1, 1979, twin infant sons Mike and Greg in 1947 and a son Thomas on October 11, 1994.
