LEXINGTON Milton E. Disser, Jr., 79, of Lexington, died Monday, September 13, 2010 in his home with his family at his side.

Milton was born June 15, 1931 in Detroit, son of the late Milton E., Sr. and Vivian (Reese) Disser.

Milton married Ruth M. (Kottmann) on August 19, 1956 in Detroit and together they had five children: Tammy (Tony Fahoome) Disser of Harrison Twp., Tina (Gary) Suerwier of Bad Axe, Maureen (Dave) Solgot of St. Clair, Milton, III (Julie) of Clearwater, FL and Steven (Lisa) of Lexington. His wife Ruth preceded him in death March 12, 1998.

Milton spent much of his career in the food industry. He traveled all over the country as a marketing specialist for Bee Gee Shrimp, of Lakeland, FL. He had been active in his community as Village of Lexington Trustee, Village President and Lexington Twp. Supervisor. He was extremely well read with interests in many areas. He was known for writing a "good" letter and people often turned to him for counsel. Milt was also a regular at his "club" Bush's Restaurant in Lexington for many years, where he was known as "Precious". Cremation has taken place and a memorial service will be held at 1:30 P.M. Sunday, September 19, 2010 at St. Matthew Lutheran Church, Lexington, with
