CROSWELL: Gene R. Clarkson, age 92, of Croswell, passed away on Thursday, May 20, 2010 at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, Port Huron. He was born April 27, 1918 in Brown City, son of the late Glenn Robert & Alta Mae (Lee) Clarkson. He and Greta Mae Westbrook were married August 3, 1941 in Croswell.

Gene was co-owner and operator of Clarkson Dairy from the 1930's to 1955. In 1955 they sold the dairy to London's Dairy and he worked there until he retired. He was a member of the Croswell United Methodist Church, Croswell Lions, Croswell Oddfellows, and the Croswell Fair Board.
