January 17, 1939 - November 14, 2018

LEXINGTON- Ralph J. Markel, age 79, a resident of Lexington and formerly of Fremont Township, passed away on Wednesday, November 14, 2018 at his home.

He was born on January 17, 1939 in Munger, Michigan, a son of the late Ralph J. and Delia (DuRussel) Markel. Ralph married Patricia L. Schafsnitz on August 2, 1958 in Reese, Michigan.

Ralph owned and operated his family farm, Markel Farms, in Fremont Township for many years. He was a member of the former St. Patricks Catholic Church in Croswell and was currently a member of the St. Denis Catholic Church in Lexington.
