



Robert E. Ogilvy, Sr.

June 16, 1921 - October 11, 2015

Lexington- Robert Earl Ogilvy, Sr. , age 94, a resident of Lexington passed away on Sunday October 11, 2015 at his residence. He was born on June 16, 1921 in Windsor, Ontario a son of the late John Earl and Alice (Taylor) Ogilvy. Robert was a Seabee in the U.S. Navy and proudly served his country during World War II. He studied to be a Naval Pilot when he met Vermell Willie and they were married on Decmeber 16, 1945 in Louisville, Georgia. She preceded him in death on February 10, 2014. Robert was a retired First Batallion Fire Chief for the Detroit Fire Department, City of Detroit. He also taught fire science at the Lansing Community College. Robert and his wife owned and operated the Lex on the Lake Lodges for 38 years.

He is survived by his daughter Margaret Vermell Ogilvy (Peter Robert Schulz), three sons Robert Earl Ogilvy, Jr., Bruce Forrest (Claudia) Ogilvy and William Edward (April) Ogilvy; 8 grandchildren and 14 great grandchildren.

He was also preceded in death by a brother James Ogilvy.
