January 30, 1920 - August 21, 2010

LEXINGTON Ruth A. Grant, 90, of Lexington, died Saturday, August 21, 2010 in Regency on the Lake, Fort Gratiot.

She was born January 30, 1920 in Lexington Township, daughter of the late George and Mada (Carr) Merrill. Ruth and Lee Grant were married December 31, 1943 in Port Huron. He died March 21, 1995.

Ruth held a Masters Degree in Education and taught elementary education in the Warren Consolidated School District for 26 years. She also taught in Deckerville and Croswell Schools. She was a member of the F. Presbyterian Church.
