CARSONVILLE- Shirley Ann (Buffett) Squires, 91, of Carsonville, passed away on March 25, 2024. Shirley was born on April 3, 1932 in Detroit Michigan to Harold and Ruth (McGowan) Buffett.

Her family moved to Sanilac County in 1937 and she remained a life-long resident.
