CROSWELL: Thomas A. Dickensheets, 55, of Croswell, died Sunday, March 7, 2010 in his home.

He was born October 6, 1954 in Yale, son of Clara J. (Torzewski) Dickensheets and the late Thomas E. Dickensheets.

Tom was Superintendent of the D.P.W. in Croswell where he had worked for 25 years. He joined the Fire Dept. in 1976 and had been the Fire Chief for 22 years. He was also past president of the Sanilac Co. Firemen's Association, president of the Sanilac Co. Police Firemen Field Day Association, a member of the Sanilac Co. Dispatch 911 committee, and a member of the Sanilac Co. Fire Training Comm.
