CROSWELL: Valeria Mae Bartley, age 97, of Port Huron, died Thursday, September 30, 2010 at Caretel Inns of Linden after a brief illness.

She was born January 11, 1913 in Croswell, the daughter of the late George J. Stewart and Vernah Grandy.

She married Robert F. Bartley January 23, 1933. He died September 29, 1968.

Valeria graduated from Croswell High School in 1931 and graduated from Derma Bay School of Beauty in Detroit in 1933. She was employed by Elevyn's Beauty Shop in Lexington before buying her own business in Croswell in 1956, where she did business as Valeria's Beauty Shop for twenty five years.
