LEXINGTON- Virginia Bett of Lexington, Michigan passed away on Monday September 5, 2022 at Waltonwood Assisted Living in Canton, Michigan at the age of 106. She was born in Des Moines, Iowa on September 24, 1915. Virginia was a devoted wife, mother and grandmother. She and her husband, Virgil, traveled extensively through Latin America and around the world. Virginia made friends easily wherever they were. She lived primarily in Grand Blanc with Virgil and two sons Bruce and David where she worked as a first-grade teacher and later directed a co-op nursery school. She and her husband moved to Lexington when they retired in the 1970s and were active in the community.
