LAKEPORT- William C. Blomme, age 91 , a resident of Lakeport, passed away on Tuesday, May 12, 2026 in Clearwater, Florida.

He was born to the late William and Esther Blomme in Detroit, Michigan on April 13, 1935. William and his high school sweetheart, Patricia Ann Strunk, were married on June 17, 1955 at St. Peter's Lutheran Church in East Detroit. William enjoyed working on cars and the yard and he and Patricia shared their retirement time in Michigan and South Pasadena, Florida.
